

## **Charleston Yacht Club 2011-2012 Dock Rules:**

Members may use the club's docks for a period of 48 hours. Any boats at the dock longer than this will be charged the Members Only specified dockage rate of \$25 per day.

Members with boats who anticipate using the dock must notify the club and be issued a member ID sticker to be placed on the boat in a visible place to identify the member's boat while at the dock.

When members expect to be at the dock overnight they must sign in on the register at the bar. Failure to sign in will mean that the member will be charged the regular dockage rate from the beginning.

In using the dock members agree that other members will be allowed to raft up to their boats as needed and they agree that their boats may be moved to a different position on the dock to make room for other boats as necessary.

Members should tie their boats in a manner to leave as much room as possible along the dock for additional boats.

No temporary docking is allowed at the finger dock below the hoist. That dock is for launching and retrieving boats with the hoist.

The Yacht Club reserves the right to restrict usage on the docks during special Club functions and events. (Charleston Race Week / Big Boat Regatta / Fishing Tournaments)

Members using the docks for "repair or maintenance" projects need to clear that activity with the Club Manager in advance and make sure any such project does not impede other member's enjoyment of the docks.
